The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari/mandamus for direction to respondent No.2 to finalize the provisional assessed bills of entry Nos.5643926, 5638596, 5638511 and 5638430 dated 3.1.2012, Annexure P.1.

2. Mr.Sourabh Goel, learned counsel representing the respondents has furnished a communication dated 23.5.2018 addressed to him by respondent No.2, wherein it has been stated that all the aforesaid four bills were finalized

on 17.2.2016. The relevant part of the said communication dated 23.5.2018 is reproduced as under:
