This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.3 and enquiry report dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) conducted by respondent No.4 whereby depot of the petitioner has been cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Food and Civil Supplies, Sector-17-E, Chandigarh to look into the appeal dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same in a time bound manner.

As per the reply, State has denied the filing of said appeal.

Heard.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to furnish another copy of the appeal to the competent authority within two weeks from today

who shall decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. The order be passed after affording due opportunity of hearing to the parties as per law. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
