JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the 23 years ACP scale which became due to the petitioner on 08.08.2003.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent(s) to decide representation dated 03.07.2017 (P-2), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in representation dated 03.07.2017 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision within a period of three months from the date of

receipt of a certified copy of this order, particularly in the light of the Circular No. 20/2000, dated 28.07.2000 (P-1) as well as in view of judgments passed by this Court in CWP No.28812 of 2017, decided on 18.12.2017, CWP No. 28849 of 2017, decided on 18.12.2017, CWP No. 29317 of 2017 decided on 21.12.2017, CWP No. 11585 of 2016, 02.06.2016 and CWP No. 20139 of 2015, decided on 29.02.2016. In case, competent authorities come to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) claimed, the same be released to him within a period of next 45 days.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
