Petitioner is a convict undergoing imprisonment in FIR No. 199 dated 03.10.2009 for offences under Sections 302 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Payal, Ludhiana, having been convicted and sentenced to life by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on 13.05.2014. On his application for grant of Parole to meet his family members, SSP Khanna, which would be place of his residence during the Parole has vide report dated 20.09.2016 (P-1) has not recommended his Parole.

The present writ petition has been filed for quashing of Order P-1.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds no ground to interfere with the recommendations of SSP Khanna at P-1. The

(petitioner) reads as under:-

“ *NOTE: He is acquitted in all FIRs except FIR 199 dated 10.12.2009*

When he was released on parole from 5.5.2016 to 17.06.2016 for 42 days, it was informed that he had association with other criminals. He was not available at home when checked. He did not attend the Police Station. He was preparing for major action.

When he came on furlough for 21 days on 9.9.2016 he did not inform the police station and did not mark his attendance at the Police Station. He may join other criminals and jump over parole.

Keeping the above report, parole is not recommended to convict Harpreet Singh @ Bhelas s/o Joginder Singh r/o Ludhiana. ”

In view of the above, no ground is made out to interfere with the report submitted by SP, Payal, Ludhiana regarding parole of petitioner.

Dismissed.
