Petitioner had competed for appointment as Lecturer in Economics against the 13 posts advertised, out of the total 130, in the Backward Class Category pursuant to the advertisement dated 20.11.2015 (P-1). It transpires that two posts advertised in the Backward Class ESM category remained unfilled and the petitioner based on his secured merit states that the aforesaid two unfilled vacancies are liable to be shifted to the category of Backward Class and thus, offered to the petitioner in view of his merit.

Upon notice, a short affidavit dated 12.01.2018 of Mr. Karamjit Singh, Deputy Director, Department of Secondary Education stands filed wherein it is conceded that the aforesaid two unfilled vacancies have been diverted to the Backward Class category and the petitioner has been offered

appointment letter as Lecturer in Economics.

The remaining grievance of the petitioner is that no posting order has yet been issued.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Vishal Shangari, Senior Assistant, office of Director Education Recruitment Directorate, Department of School Education, Punjab, Phase-3-B-1, Mohali states that order regarding place of posting would be issued to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous. State shall be bound by its stand.
