The petitioners were engaged as seasonal Malaria Workers and were disengaged in the year 2016-17. The work is seasonal in nature and lasts for about 4 ½ months in a year. The petitioners have approached this Court for directions to re-engage them as per their priority in the priority list of seasonal workers in the Malaria Eradication Programme.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Civil Surgeon-cum-District Malaria Officer, Karnal to look into the grievances of the petitioners in the light of the Scheme dated 07.05.1991 (Annex. P-3), and if it still applicable, then to take a decision especially having due regard to the cases of Balbir and Ram Sarup listed at Sr. No. 2 & 5 respectively in Annex. P-1 who were stated to have crossed the age of 58 years and are recalled for work and to see whether similar benefit can be granted.

With the above directions, the present petition is disposed of. The decision be taken within a fortnight from the date of receiving a certified copy of the order after hearing the petitioners.
