MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral)

The petitioner prays for quashing of a resolution passed by the Gram Panchayat in the year 2009. He states that Gram Panchayat land has been illegally transferred to a developer.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the opinion that the petition is hit by delay and laches. The petitioner being a Sarpanch would certainly have been alive to the earlier decision of the Gram Panchayat and if not a Sarpanch or Panch then at least as a resident of the village. After 9 years, we are not inclined to interfere in writ jurisdiction particularly when it has not been shown to us that the transfer of land has been done in violation of law and rules. The petition is silent in this regard.
