In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the communication dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-7) between Assistant Labour Commissioner and Labour Inspector relating to examination of complaint in respect of election of M.E.S.L Workers Union through secret ballot in the factory.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not pointed out whether Assistant Labour Commissioner has got jurisdiction in respect of entertaining a complaint relating to election of M.E.S.L Workers Union. Therefore, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the communication dated 3.4.2018 (Annexure P-7) or for issuance of direction.

3. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach the Labour Commissioner.
