This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to consider the petitioner for transfer in view of the notifications/policies dated 11.04.2017 and 21.06.2017 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively) passed by Government of Punjab, Personnel Department and Director Education Department (SE), Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that case of the petitioner is covered by notifications dated 11.04.2017 and 21.06.2017 (Annexures P-4 and P-5, respectively). Further, he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, PSEB Building, Phase-8, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 02.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) in the light of Annexures P-4 and P-5.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, PSEB Building, Phase-8, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 02.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) in the light of Annexures P-4 and P-5 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
