The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 05.12.2017 (Anexure P-7) being illegal and violative of Articles 14 and 19 (i) (g) of Constitution of India; with a further prayer for quashing the tender dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-10). A further prayer has also been made for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to allot the tender to the petitioners being successful bidder in the financial bid.

2. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that inadvertently certain necessary parties could not be impleaded in the writ petition and therefore, he may be

allowed to withdraw the present petition as well as CM No.6838 of 2018 with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one on the same cause of action.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to file fresh writ petition on the same cause of action with better particulars.
