Learned counsel for the petitioners states that violations with specifics have not been pointed out to them. He has placed reliance on the decision of this Court rendered in CWP 6883 of 2018 titled as **Ravi Rathore and others vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 19.3.2018.

Therefore, while disposing of the writ petition in the same terms as in CWP no.6883 of 2018, we direct the competent authority to point out the violations not only in the cases of the petitioners but all the residents of the Sainik Colony, Sector 49, NIT, Faridabad within four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. If any violations are pointed out, it shall be the obligation on the petitioners as also the residents of the area to remove such violations within six weeks thereafter.

Disposed of in above terms.

Till the time the violations are not pointed out, demolition etc.
shall not be insisted upon by the official respondents.
