The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the amount of gratuity and leave encashment as well as other benefits, for which, he is entitled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner served a legal notice dated 02.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) upon the respondents but neither any action has been taken nor the benefits have been released to him. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to take action on the pending legal notice within a limited period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take action on the legal notice dated 02.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law and release the benefits to the petitioner for which he is found to be entitled. In case, the petitioner is not found to be entitled for some of the relief for any sufficient reason, a detailed speaking order be passed.

The necessary exercise be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
