In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 14.9.2017 (Annexure P-4). For the purpose of evidence to show that petitioner has worked from July 1981 to 31.07.2013, no material has been placed except a self-serving statement of the petitioner. The management witness has stated in his examination and cross-examination that petitioner was appointed in the year 2004. Except that no material has been placed on record. Therefore, findings given by the Labour Court in para 13, it is evident that in the absence of necessary material to show that petitioner has worked during the period from July, 1981 to 31.07.2013 is taken note of and petitioner has not made out case. Thus, there is no infirmity in the award passed by the Labour Court dated 14.09.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Petition stands dismissed.
