ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter in issue is squarely covered by an order and judgment dated 15.05.2013, rendered by this Court in CWP No.11254 of 2010 (**Neelam Rani v. State of Haryana and others**). And, therefore, the present petition too is required to be disposed of in the same terms.

The factual position, as set out above, is not disputed by learned State counsel, who rather submits that let the matter be disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court in Neelam Rani's case (supra). However, he points out that the claim of the petitioner as regards arrears be confined to a period of 38 months, prior to the date of filing of this petition, as ordered by this Court in many subsequent matters.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners give up their claim vis-à-vis the period beyond 38 months preceding the date of filing the petition.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court in Neelam Rani's case (supra). It is clarified that the petitioners shall only be entitled to arrears of pay/salary for a period of 38 months.
