The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.1 to hear ROR No.186 of 2018, which is fixed for hearing on 23.08.2018 to some early actual date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a long date has been given in the case and the petitioner would be the sufferer as warrant of possession has been issued on 23.04.2018, which is to be executed on 04.05.2018. Learned counsel also submits that the application for preponing was moved on 25.04.2018 but the same was not entertained. Learned counsel further submits that the purpose of filing the revision petition would be frustrated, in case, the warrant of possession is executed. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to respondent No.1 to hear the revision petition filed by the petitioner on some early date.

Keeping in view the limited prayer and submissions made by

learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to hear the revision petition by preponing the date within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case, for any sufficient reason, the revision petition is not heard prior to 23.08.2018, then the same be heard within a period of four weeks and the prayer for interim stay be considered.

However, *status quo* be maintained till decision of revision petition.
