By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to commute his salary and release the same as per the order of detachment passed by the learned JMIC, Hisar vide order dated 11.07.2017 in case titled Devender Vs. Ved Singh (P-2) and grant him all the retiral benefits including gratuity, leave encashment along-with interest @ 18%.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated July 13, 2017 (P-7) was moved to respondent No.3 but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the representation dated July 13, 2017 (P-7) in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
