On our asking, Mr.Sahil Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.

Let four copies of the writ petition be handed-over to him during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the nature of order which we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any counter-reply from respondent Nos.1 to 4 or to serve other respondents at this stage as no order prejudicial to their interest is being passed on merits.

The grievance of the petitioner-bank in the instant writ petition is that the District Magistrate, Jalandhar has passed an order under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, way back on 17.02.2016 to

assets but till date no effective assistance has been provided by the official respondents.

We are not aware of legal impediment, if any, in giving effect to the above-stated order though, according to the petitioner-bank, there is no such obstacle and the order can be given effect. The writ petition is thus disposed of without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to ascertain the correct facts and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
