At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that detailed representations were made to various police authorities and the Administrative authorities including Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram but no action has been taken thereupon so far. Learned counsel also submits that a detailed representation was made to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram on 08.05.2017 and till date, no action has been taken thereupon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to consider the pending representation within some short span of time.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

respondent No.5 i.e The Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to take necessary action on representation dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-20) in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

However, it is made clear that in case, respondent No.5 thinks appropriate to hear the concerned authorities for taking decision, the opportunity be given to them.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
