1.5 acres of land was allotted for the petitioner school. Later on, litigation took place and on the orders of this Court, the Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, Town and Country Planning and Urban Estates Departments, Chandigarh vide order dated 4.8.2015 (Annexure P4), allotted one acre land to the petitioner school.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at that time, it was represented by the HUDA that only one acre land is available against 1.5 acres of land allotted to the petitioner school. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that now under RTI information (Annexure P10), he has come to know that adjoining land is lying vacant and has not been allotted to anybody. The department claims that it is earmarked for the post office.

Petitioner has issued a legal notice dated 12.7.2016 (Annexure P6) to respondent no.1.

In these circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent no.1 to take note of the legal notice dated 12.7.2016 (Annexure P6) served by the petitioner and the facts stated in the present writ petition and take a decision thereon in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
