In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner had even earlier filed Civil Writ Petition No.
4044 of 2018, which was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to pursue his
representation, dated 11.1.2018. The limited grievance that he has is; that
post passing of the order dated 22.2.2018, the petitioner again represented to
the respondent authorities, vide representation dated 24.2.2018 (Annexure P-
8), and even though a considerable time has elapsed, but to no avail.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also his representations, dated 11.1.2018 (Annexure P-6) and 24.2.2018 (Annexure P-8), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent authorities, within a period of eight weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioner is declined/rejected, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
