In the instant petition, grievance of the petitioner is that respondent is not entitled to gratuity having regard to the defect in his appointment. In other words, his appointment is not in accordance with law when it was issued in the year 1990 and further promotion granted to the respondent was also not in accordance with law. As long as those orders are not modified or withdrawn in accordance with law. Respondent is entitled to gratuity. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the order of the Controlling as well as Appellate Authorities.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
