JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the benefit of gratuity, leave encashment etc. and to take action on the legal notice dated 18.05.2015 (P-5) within some specified time .

2. No doubt, in response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, respondents have filed reply by way of short affidavit of Jangi Lal Oswal, CMD, Malwa Cotton Spinning Mills Ltd., Barnala, District Barnala, yet one thing is evident that respondents No.2 & 3 are private identities and are not amenable to writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Mr. Bhupinder Banga, Advocate appearing on behalf of

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respondents No.2 & 3 has submitted that in the reply, details have been furnished with regard to amounts, which have already been paid and which are still to be paid by the respondents No.2 & 3. Otherwise also, respondents No.2 & 3 are ready to make the payment thereof i.e. Rs.2,82,727/-.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to make the payment of the amount which is concededly to be paid by them to the tune of Rs.2,82,727/- within period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Further, if the petitioner is still aggrieved with regard to the calculations made by the respondents No.2 & 3, he shall be at liberty to approach the concerned Forum for redressal of his grievances.
