The petitioner seeks to rely on an experience certificate Annex P-7 issued to him by the B.S.N. High School, Village Sanwar, Bhiwani for the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is not impressed to put the Commission on notice. Though in the petition it is averred that the experience certificate has already been submitted while applying for the post through on-line process, but the downloaded copy of the on-line application form has not been produced to ascertain; whether the experience certificate now claimed was or was not mentioned in the on-line application form and its original produced at the time of scrutiny and verification of documents, which is the requirement of the advertisement. However, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the petitioner has passed the driving proficiency test, this Court

directs the Haryana Staff Selection Commission to check its record and confirm; whether the petitioner has mentioned anything about the experience certificate (Annex P-7) in his on-line application form. If yes, then the Commission would consider the case of the petitioner for the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver. In case, the petitioner has not mentioned about the experience certificate in the on-line process, the Commission is at liberty to decline the case of the petitioner straightway. The Commission is also at liberty to verify the original experience certificate, as there is far too much space between the handwriting part and the signatures of the Headmaster, Bal Shiksha Niketan High School, Sanwar (Charkhi Dadri), Haryana issuing the certificate of experience.

With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
