By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release death-cum-retiral gratuity and commutation of pension to her accrued to her on account of death of her husband from the date of voluntary retirement of her husband i.e. 28.02.2015 along-with interest @18% per annum on the delayed payment thereof.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner moved representation dated 11.12.2017 (P-8) with regard to the release of afore-said relief but despite the fact that a period of four months has expired, neither any reply has been received from the authorities nor any conscious decision has been taken thereon, by the authorities till date. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said representation dated 11.12.2017 (P-8) with in some stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case as well as in view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 11.12.2017 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
