2. In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the following relief:

“(ii) May issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction especially in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the list of provisionally shortlisted for pre-employment Medical Examination (PEME) against Advt. PR/P/41 (2017-18) Annexure P-5 dated 23.04.2018 wherein name of respondent No.3 figures in for the post of Jr. E.A.-IV (Fire & Safety) post code 107 being illegal, arbitrary and contrary to (Annexure P-2A and P-3), further respondent No.3 has been illegally shortlisted as Junior Engineering Assistant-IV (Fire & Safety) by respondent No.2 ignoring (Annexure P-2A and P-3).”

3. Having regard to the prayer made to the extent of quashing the list of provisionally shortlisted candidates for pre-employment Medical Examination pursuant to the advertisement dated 23.04.2018, petitioner is permitted to file objections if she has got any grievance against the provisional list of shortlisted candidates for pre-employment Medical Examination. If such objections are presented/filed, in that event, competent

authority is hereby directed to examine the petitioner's objection to the provisional list of shortlisted candidates for pre-employment Medical Examination and thereafter proceed to finalize and notify.

4. With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.
