This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India directing the respondent-bank to refund the loan processing fees wrongfully debited from the loan account of the petitioner's firm and to pay interest @ 18% per annum from the date of deduction of the amount from the petitioner's firm's account.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that certain factual matrix are required to be established and prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies before the Civil Court or any other alternative remedy as available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
