LIC of India and anr. Vs. Smt.Kamla and anr.

Present: Mr.Rajneesh Malhotra, Advocate for the petitioners.

Mr.Gulshan Nandwani, Advocate for respondent No.1.

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The matter has been discussed. Parties have agreed to compromise the present dispute. Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that respondent No.1 may be directed to withdraw the amount of ₹2,33,783/- which was already deposited by the petitioners with Permanent Lok Adalat, Gurgaon. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has also stated that respondent No.1 is ready to accept the said amount as full and final payment of her claim and that respondent No.1 relinquishes her right to further interest from the date of deposit with Permanent Lok Adalat till today. It has also been stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that in case validity date of the draft had expired, petitioners would revalidate the same and ensure payment of the said amount to respondent No.1 as per compromise. She has also stated that respondent No.1 be directed to receive the said D.D. from Permanent Lok Adalat and hand over the same to the petitioners so that the same may be revalidated. It has been stated by learned counsel for the parties that the present writ petition be disposed of accordingly.

Accordingly, respondent No.1 is entitled to an amount of ₹2,33,783/- as full and final settlement of the claim from the petitioners.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
