Petitioner was recruited as Steno-typist on regular basis w.e.f. 16.08.2013. The maximum period of probation provided is two years.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the decision on the clearing of the probation period is being unnecessary delayed by the office of Civil Surgeon, S.B.S. Nagar-respondent no.3, thereby denying the benefit of the release of annual increments to the petitioner w.e.f. the date of initial appointment.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Dr. Narinder Pal Sharma, SMO, PHC Muzaffarnagar office of Civil Surgeon states that the office of DHS has passed an order dated 23.5.2018 whereby the probation period of the petitioner has been ordered to be cleared w.e.f. 15.08.2015.

She further states that in view of the necessary relief claimed having been granted present writ petition has become infructuous.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid submission.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand of the parties, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
