JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 02.06.2017, passed the following order:-

“*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred from ESI Hospital, Hoshiarpur to PHC Kasoana, Ferozepur (Punjab) although he has sent his request for premature retirement by giving three months' advance notice w.e.f. 01.04.2017 and even otherwise, he is due for superannuation on 31.05.2018. Learned counsel further contends that the wife of the petitioner is posted at Hoshiarpur and the petitioner is suffering from various ailments including deranged liver function and medical report has been appended as Annexure P-9.*

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Avinit Avasthi, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Let, five sets of copies of paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

List on 24.07.2017.

The operation of the impugned order dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) qua the petitioner shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has sought voluntary retirement w.e.f. 30.06.2017.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
