RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner's entry into service was based on a fraudulent act committed by her by forging a transfer order on the basis of which she joined R.E.Division Patiala. She also obtained a forged medical certificate purported to be issued by the Civil Surgeon, Bathinda. She also made forged entries in a bogus service book and continued to serve for 14 years without undergoing the written test for recruitment to the post of Lower Division Clerk. She had not passed any type test and no appointment letter was ever issued to her. Yet, she had the audacity to raise a dispute and seek reference. During trial she admitted to all this in her cross-examination before the Industrial Tribunal, Patiala.

2. When these facts were discovered by the management, her services were terminated. Her statutory appeal was rejected.

3. The Labour Court has declined the reference after analysing the facts from record. There can be no doubt that the petition has to be dismissed. It is ordered accordingly.
