The instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 24.01.2014 and 27.08.2014 (Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively), whereby, the salary of the petitioner has been revised and arrears of revised salary have been ordered to be recovered.

As per the reply, the salary of the petitioner has been re-fixed as per table No.10 of Revised Pay Fixation Rules, 2009 and therefore, the grouse of the petitioner has been fully redressed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the necessary relief has been allowed to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, as the order is being passed in the absence of learned senior counsel for the petitioner, if any grouse or claim remains unaddressed, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revive the present petition within three months from today.
