The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents No. 1 to 4 for taking strict legal action against respondents No. 5 to 8 as respondent No. 6 has sold a plot to respondent No. 8 vide registered sale deed dated 25.11.2013 vide vasika No. 3702 and after that this plot has been given on lease where the company has installed the mobile tower, which is illegal.

On notice of this petition, reply has been filed by respondent No. 5. It is stated therein that no sale deed has been registered within the revenue limit of village Malout as mentioned in the petition as the sale deed No. 3702 dated 25.11.2013 (Annexure R-5/1-T) has been registered by the respondent but this sale deed is with regard to land situated within Lal Lakir (Red Dora) of the village and there are no Khewat, Khatauni Khasra or Killa Nos. of land mentioned in the same.

In a separate reply filed by respondent No. 4 on 08.12.2017, it is stated that after receiving the letter dated 12.06.2017 (Annexure R-2) from office of Deputy Commissioner, the deponent visited the spot and directed to the village

Sarpanch to file ejectment petition in the Court of D.D.P.O. Sri Muktsar Sahib and vide letter dated 22.06.2017 (Annexure R-3) reminder has been sent and again reminder has been sent on 14.07.2017 (Annexure R-4).

Learned counsel for the State has informed that ejectment petition has been filed on 13.11.2018 and is listed on 20.11.2018.

No further order is required to be passed.
