Prima facie we do not find any provision for reservation of ex-serviceman/wards of ex-serviceman in the process adopted for admission in post graduate courses in the medical stream. However, since the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has made a representation, we would without commenting on the merits of the claim made in the present petition, deem it appropriate to direct that the respondents may consider the representation (Annexure P-13) and take a decision thereon expeditiously. Ordered accordingly.

By way of abundant caution, we make it clear that this order should not be construed to be an expression on the merits of the claim raised in the petition.
