Petitioners pray that they have been allotted small dwelling units/plots for dwelling units as they belong to the BPL category but the area which has been provided did not have basic amenities.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that this petition can be disposed of without issuance of notice of motion to other side. Right to live with dignity is a fundamental right, and therefore looking at the nature of the prayer made, we are of the opinion that if dwelling units/plots for dwelling units have been provided, they should obviously be accompanied by the basic facilities which are required for decent leaving.

We, therefore, direct the Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat to look into the grievance of the petitioners and provide the basic amenities that are essential for decent living.

Petition stands disposed of.
