The petitioner applied for the post of Clerk in the category of dependents of Ex-Serviceman. It is alleged that in the written test he scored more marks than the last candidate and yet he was not called for interview. Thereafter, legal notice dated 20.03.2018 (Annexure P-8), has been issued, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Before the interview was conducted, the petitioner was aware of the fact that he had scored more marks than the last candidate in the list of candidates declared successful in the written test. Yet, he did not agitate his claim before the concerned authorities or before this Court. Now, the selection is complete and the final result has been declared. No relief can be granted to the petitioner at this stage.

In view of the above, the writ petition is misconceived and is accordingly dismissed.
