The petitioners have filed the present writ petition claiming to be the legal heirs of Sh. Heera Lal, who died while in service on 06.03.2011.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that said Sh. Heera Lal was appointed as Peon on regular basis and he continued to serve till he died on 06.03.2011. It has been prayed that the benefits accruing to said Heera Lal should be disbursed to the petitioners, which are not being done by the respondents without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners had taken time to place on record order dated 04.06.1984 to show this Court that the said Heera Lal was appointed on regular basis and thus, was entitled for the benefits for the service, which he had rendered prior to his death. No such document has been placed so far.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the

petitioners had given representations to the respondents for release of the benefits and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a direction is given to the respondents to decide their claim by passing a speaking order on the representations dated 21.05.2017, 05.11.2017 and 06.03.2018 Annexures P-1 to P-3 respectively.

Without going into the merits of the case or opining on the claim made by the petitioners in the representations, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass appropriate speaking order in respect of the claim which the petitioners have made vide representations dated 21.05.2017, 05.11.2017 and 06.03.2018 Annexures P-1 to P-3 respectively within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case it is found after passing of the order that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to them within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
