The prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents for setting aside the order dated 18.5.2017 (Annexure P-5) whereby the petitioner was initially transferred from Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Jahangirpur to D.E.O, Jhajjar and then on 30.5.2017 after 12 days he was transferred from DEO Office, Jhajjar to GGHS Jahangirpur District Jhajjar.

Earlier the petitioner has filed **CWP No. 22978 of 2016 Hari Om Vs. State of Haryana and others** challenging his transfer order from Jhajjar to Rohtak. During the pendency of the aforesaid writ petition as per interim order dated 7.12.2016 the petitioner was adjusted at Jahangirpur which was about 10 K.M.from Jhajjar vide order dated 30.12.2016

After disposal of the writ petition, the petitioner was again transferred from GGHS Jahangirpur to DEO Office, Jhajjar vide order dated 18/19.5.2017 (Annexure P-5) against Anil Kumar-respondent No.3.

On a representation made by Anil Kumar, this transfer order was cancelled vide order dated 30.12.2016. As per the transfer policy of Class-III and IV employees dated 6.10. 2004 (Annexure P-7) this Court is of the view that once the petitioner was adjusted at GGHS Jahangirpur vide order dated 30.05.2017, he could not be transferred before expiry of two years. Hence the transfer order 18.5.2017 from Jahangirpur to Jhajjar has been rightly cancelled. This order was passed after disposal of the writ petition No.22978 of 2016.

No ground for interference is made out.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
