JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant family pension along-with interest @18% per annum, on account of death of her husband with further direction to count the daily wage service rendered by the husband of the petitioner as qualifying service more than 15 years and to release the same along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted petitioner has made various representations including representation dated July 17, 2017 (P-10) but till date no action has been taken on the same. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the afore-said representation in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances put forth by the petitioner in her representation (P-10) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of judgments referred to in the afore-said representation within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
