Application is allowed as prayed for and documents (P-5 & P-6) are taken on record subject to all just exceptions and be tagged at appropriate place.

Main Case

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to revise his pensionary benefits after granting the salary of post of Principal to him w.e.f. 21.05.2004 to 31.12.2009 along with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner moved a legal notice dated 11.12.2007 to the respondents but till date

despite the fact more than ten years has elapsed, no conscious decision has been taken even no response has also been received. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide aforesaid legal notice (P-2), in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (Secondary), Punjab, Sector 17, U.T., Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 11.12.2007 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law including filing of writ petition.
