By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears (difference of salary) of the salary to her during her re-employment from July 2015 to March 2016 along-with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that petitioner moved representation dated 30.08.2017 (P-2) to respondent No.4 followed by reminder dated 02.11.2017 (P-3) but despite the fact that a period of more than four months is going elapsed, no response has been received by the authorities till date. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said representation dated 30.08.2017 (P-2) within some stipulated period.

3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the afore-said legal representation dated 30.08.2017 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
