AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing of impugned order dated 07.05.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Registrar-cum-First Appellate Authority, Hisar-respondent No.3 under the Right to Information Act, order dated 02.02.2015 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Chief Information Commissioner, Haryana, vide which the information to the petitioner on points 8 to 10 of the Right of the Information Act was denied by the State Public Information Officer, claiming exemption under Section 8(1)(e) of the Right to Information Act, 2005. When the case came up for hearing on 28.01.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion only to the limited extent regarding supply of

information pertaining to the funds being received and utilised by the university in question, for 4.7.2016.

Second prayer of the petitioner regarding information of the industries which have been seeking help of the laboratory in analyzing the samples is rejected as the impugned order would not suffer from any infirmity as the laboratory concerned is not obliged to give details and particulars of its clients with whom it has a fiduciary relationship.”

In view of the above order, the limited information, which was required to be supplied to the petitioner was with regard to the funds being received and utilized by the University, which information has been supplied to him by respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and 8, details whereof has been appended as Annexure R-1 colly with the reply filed to the writ petition.

In view of the above, the present writ petition does not survive and the same is, therefore, dismissed.
