The petitioners are working as *Safai Karmacharis*. Their services have been regularised, vide the order dated 11.08.2014. The grievance of the petitioners is that the policy of regularization came into being on 01.04.2011 and the services of similarly situated persons, were regularised with effect from that date. Thus, the petitioners have been discriminated against. In this regard, representation dated 21.06.2017, (Annexure P-1), has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3, to consider the representation dated 21.06.2017 (Annexure P-1), objectively and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
