The grievance of the petitioners in the instant writ petition is against the notification dated 27.02.2018 (P-5) issued under Section 3A of the National Highways Act, 1956.

It is not in dispute that the petitioners have already filed objections (P-6) against the said notification, *inter-alia*, alleging that the State of Punjab, Town and Country Planning Department has granted them 'change of land use' permission and their drawings have already been approved for construction of a School at the site.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

We have no reason to doubt that the Competent Authority shall duly consider the objections submitted by the petitioners, before issuance of final notification and would obviously see whether or not the subject land is required for construction of National Highway. The writ petition is thus disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the objections filed by the petitioners, before issuance of final notification.

Ordered accordingly.
