By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to count the previous service rendered by her in the office of respondent No.5 as PRT teacher w.e.f. 12.10.1984 to 04.02.1987 and for protection of her pay, pension, gratuity and other retiral benefits and accordingly, grant retiral benefits/arrears after revising the same.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner moved representation dated 15.02.2018 (P-9) to respondents No.4 and 5 with regard to counting of her previous service w.e.f. 12.10.1984 to 04.02.1997 rendered by her in the office of respondent No.5 but despite the fact that a period of more than one month is going to expire no response has been received by the authorities. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a

direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-9) within some time bound manner.

3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 15.02.2018 (P-9) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
