1. The prayer made in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus by way of filing a Public Interest Litigation, *inter alia*, is for direction to respondent No.1 to formulate a special statute relating to the field of Prosthetics, Orthotics Science.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars as proper parties had not been arrayed in the petition who were not having requisite license.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition

with better particulars as also by giving the details of public interest activities undertaken by the petitioner.
