By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant family pension along-with interest @18% per annum, on account of death of her husband.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation (P-7) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances put forth by the petitioner in her representation (P-7) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of judgments (Annexures P-4 to P-6) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
