The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the decision dated 21.09.2017 (Annexure P-6/T) passed by respondent No.2 regarding repayment of penal rent recovered from respondent No.7 for her overstay in House No.46, Sector 2, Chandigarh from 04.04.2012 to 13.07.2013.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain relevant facts could not be incorporated and necessary documents appended along with the writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition as well as Civil Misc. No.5084 of 2018, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.
