In the instant writ petition, petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

(i) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction against the respondents in processing and accepting the resignation of the petitioner as Sub Inspector without insisting on deliberate undue demands and further returning the original testimonials retained by the respondents to the petitioner so that his future career/study prospects and livelihood are not jeopardized any further.

(ii) With further prayer to ensure that the petitioner is not subjected to further harassment and his hardships are not aggravated and he is given a neat and clean relieving from service on account of extreme adverse family and job circumstances and all his pending dues accumulated during the service tenure are released to him”.

Pursuant to the previous order, office order has been passed by the competent authority on 12.12.2017. In view of the office order, present petition do not survive for consideration. Accordingly CWP stands disposed

of. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to challenge office order dated 12.12.2017 if he is aggrieved.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out relating to return of original testimonials of the petitioner which is stated to be returned. Concerned authority is hereby directed to verify if the documents have not been returned to the petitioner, forthwith he is directed to return.
