Petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition for quashing of notice issued under Section 246(1) read with Section 246(A) of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976.

As per case of the petitioners, they are having small size shops at Moga for earning their livelihood and are regularly paying the rent as well as electricity bills of these shops.

A notice was issued to the petitioners on 29.12.2017 and reply to said notice was to be filed within a period of seven days but the same has not been filed. In stead of giving reply to the notice, the petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

No direction can be issued and the impugned order cannot be quashed as the petitioners have not filed reply of the notice.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to make representation or file reply to notice dated 29.12.2017 within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The respondents are directed to take action on the notice after

filing the reply within a period of two weeks. In case, the respondent authorities are not satisfied with the reply, a detailed speaking order be passed after hearing the petitioners.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
