AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly states that since the Panchayats in Punjab have been dissolved, the present petition in the present form, may not be maintainable. However, he states that in case after the fresh elections, the school land is misused or the misuse continues and no steps taken by the new Panchayat, liberty may be granted to the petitioners to approach the competent authority highlighting this aspect.

2. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or stating anything further in the matter, as per the statement of the counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the competent authority to highlight the grievance with regard to the misuse of the school land, if it continues even after the fresh election of the Gram Panchayat.
